



Gary Reshefsky, Esq.

Gary is a principal in Century Risk Advisors, an insurance agency based in Boca Raton. Gary is involved in all facets of CRA's operations with his primary focus being delivering excellent service to CRA's clients. Gary also leads Public Risk Advisors, a related risk management consulting firm that provides consulting services to public entities and other similar institutions.

From 2008 until November 2012, Gary was a Partner in the MDW Insurance Group based in Coral Gables, Florida. Gary was primarily focused on providing best-in-class client service and risk management counsel to MDW's clients. Gary often took on special projects for clients in need of consultative risk management services. Internally, Gary managed MDW's commercial insurance operations and also acted as legal counsel overseeing legal issues within the company.

Gary has a long background in the insurance industry dating back to the early 1990's. While in college, he worked in the Chicago insurance market and Lloyd's of London in England. His career in Florida began as a legislative counsel at the City of Miami in 2000 and then as an attorney with the law firm Greenberg Traurig in Miami. In 2004, he returned to risk management full time, joining USI Insurance Services as Director of Risk Management Services. At that time, USI was the largest privately-owned insurance broker in the United States. While at USI, Gary managed the insurance and risk management programs for entities of all sizes including multi-national companies with diverse insurance exposures.

From July 2010 to June 2011, Gary acted as the City of Miami's Director of Risk Management, which is the third largest City department next to Police and Fire. In this role, Gary oversaw a \$60 million risk management budget. Specific tasks and accomplishments included a redesign of the City's health care plan; restructuring of the City's property insurance program; placement of an enhanced liability and Workers' Compensation program; introduction of a cloud-based Risk Management Information System; redesign of claims management processes; and various other risk management activities.

Gary earned a BBA in Finance from The George Washington University in 1996, and a JD and MBA from the University of Miami in 1999. He is a member of the Florida Bar and holds multiple insurance licenses. He is a graduate of the Chubb Risk Management program and a candidate for the Registered Professional Liability Underwriter insurance designation.

Dating back to college, Gary has continuously served in a leadership role in some form of community board or organization. These include the City of Miami Homeland Defense Bond Oversight Board from 2002 to 2010 where he served as *Chairman of the Audit Committee*. The Board was charged with oversight of the expenditure of proceeds from a \$255 million municipal bond offering. He helped establish practices and procedures for efficient expenditures and timely delivery of projects. Since 2005 Gary has also served as *Vice President and Finance Committee Member* of the Miami Children's Museum. In this role he provides guidance and sets policy for a large Miami cultural institution. The Museum is dedicated to enriching the lives of young children in Miami-Dade County through interactive education. Gary has served on the University of Miami Citizens Board and the UM Law School Alumni Board of Directors where he chaired the 2009 Reunion Committee.
